Our Aim

The project aimed to develop a didactic-pedagogical Model for participatory teaching and learning of Religion, supporting students in the development of autonomous and critical reflections on religious pluralism in Europe.

This Model encourages a vision of multicultural European citizenship, supporting spiritual education in a dialogical perspective, opening up to all the actors of the Educating Communities of the involved territories: students, teachers, school staff but also school managers and parents. The methodological approach of **LIFETWO** is based on the promotion of mutual understanding and acceptance of religious diversities, meant as an added value as well as on the attitude of non-religious, empathetic and oriented to critical thinking in the context of spiritual education.
